COVID-19: Day of Reflection 2024

On 3 March, Marie Curie is holding the fourth Day of Reflection, encouraging people to come together to remember those who died during the COVID-19 outbreak. Councils are encouraged to get involved to ensure that bereaved people can take a moment to acknowledge their grief, take time and space to reflect and commemorate, and to support one another.

There are a number of ways in which councils and residents can get involved:

- Join the Moment of Silence at midday on 3 March
- Light up council buildings in commemoration of those we have lost
- Ask councillors to share their involvement on social media and with people living in their ward
- Encourage residents and local businesses/organisations to get involved by signposting them to the [Day of Reflection website](#) and the [downloadable resources and toolkits available to support with involvement in the day](#)
- Host a council event, and encourage council staff, organisations and residents to host a reflective activity for colleagues and/or their community and provide them the resources enabling them to take part.
