Hi Laura,

Firstly apologies for my delayed reply.

So essentially, if you are designing a new park or complete refurbishment, we can either work on a project with you from the start, through to the design process or you can submit your plans for us to review. The cost for an audit is £795, however this cost can be offset to the tender, so for example you can say that as part of the tender process that the plans need to adhere to the PiPA Guidelines, therefore there is no actual cost to the council.

I am obviously aware that you manage a number a large number of parks so I am more than happy to come and go through everything with you and we can look at how best we can be involved from a PiPA perspective, but also I still want to be able to support the council where I can personally, with obviously already having a connection with Haydon Wick Parish and with living in Swindon this is obviously easy for me to do so.

I have attached for you a copy of the checklist so you can have a look through it and see the difference between Bronze, Silver and Gold Accredited Sites and to get an idea of what the checklist includes. You can then use this if you want to start looking at some of your current sites. (Again, more than happy to go through this with you)
