Officer's Recommendations:

1. To approve Company D to proceed with the electrical aspect of the defibrillator cabinet installation and invoice The Redeemed Christian Church of God for £261.69.
2. To approve the in-house costs of installation of up to £100.00 to be met by budget 4102/102.

Background

A defibrillator was supplied free of charge to the parish from The Redeemed Christian Church of God. The donation included a contribution of 50% towards annual maintenance costs and installation up to £300.00. Three locations to site the unit were considered, to the side of the pedestrian entrance gate was the preferred location.

Installation Quotations

Four contractors were asked to provide a quotation to carry out the electrical aspect of the installation. The defibrillator houses a small electrical heater to maintain a temperature of 5 degrees centigrade, so energy consumption will be minimal.

Quotes submitted:

Company A	£419.47
Company B	£367.50
Company C	£306.00
Company D	£261.69

There will be additional in-house costs to supply and install a suitable back board to carry the defibrillator cabinet. These costs will be labour neutral and approximately £100 material costs to be met by budget 4102/102 (repairs and replacements/parish office) £500.00 available from 1 April 2023.
