Design criteria



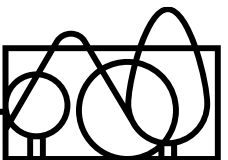
Needs:

- Minimum 4m width
- Usually fenced with a gate

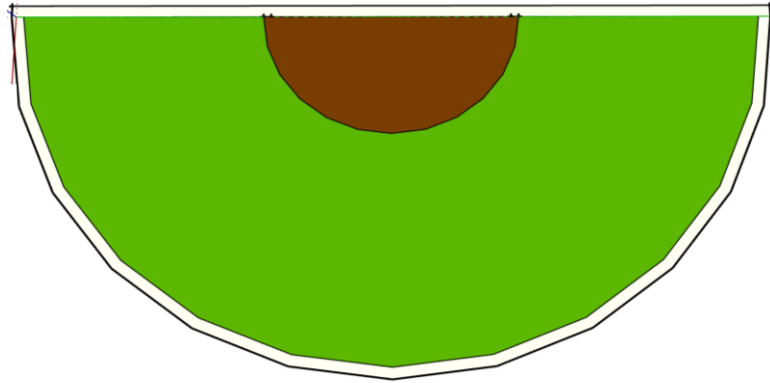


Options:

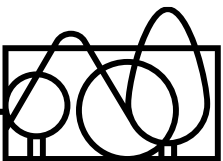

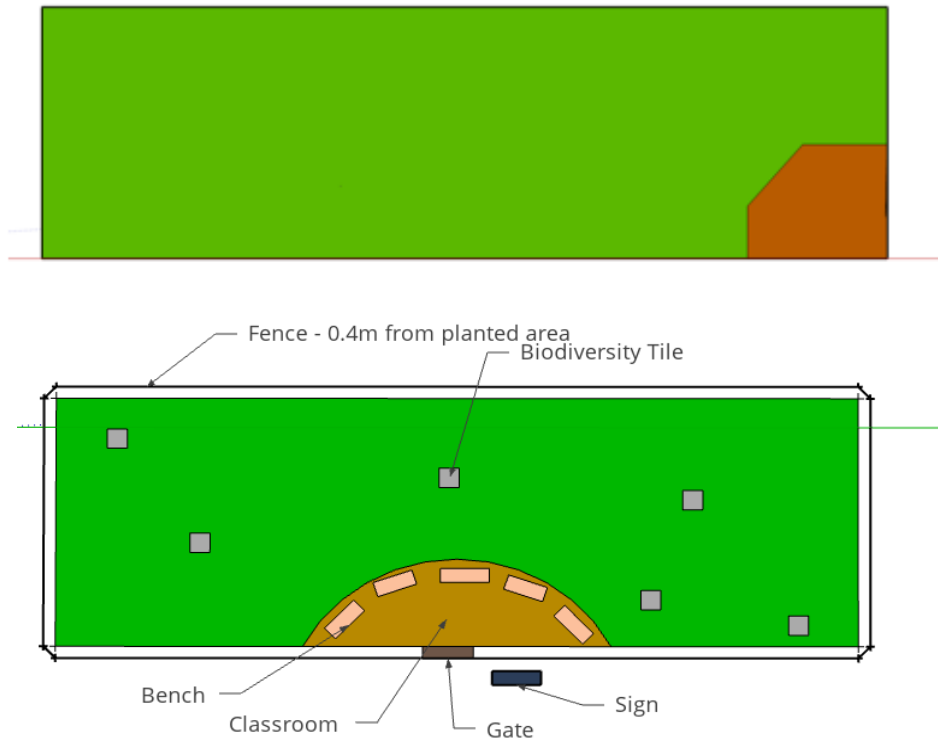

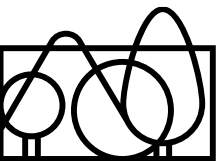

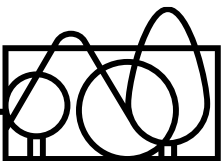

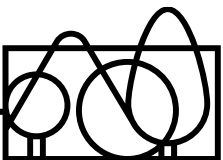
