Therefore, SBC have given The Well church use of The Underground space, at The Orbital, for selected hours, to establish an after-school drop-in youth centre. The after-school drop-in will initially run on Mondays and Tuesdays, 3.15 - 6.00pm, for students in Year 7-11. There is scope to increase this to four days a week, with additional spin-off sessions (e.g. mental health support).

	The after-school drop-in centre aims to provide
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	young people with a purposeful space to call their own, where they can relax and spend time with their friends in a safe environment. Alongside this, young people can build positive relationships with the youth workers and volunteers and access additional support and enrichment activities. Currently, the Underground is an outdated blank canvas in need of a refresh, with new furniture, games and equipment. We are applying for funds to put towards the start up costs of transforming the Underground into a fun youth centre, that will serve the young people in the Haydon Wick parish and surrounding areas. Grant money would go towards the following: - basic redecorating - new furniture, including bean bags and comfortable chairs - games and game equipment, including playstation consoles and screens, a table tennis table and board games - food and drink appliances including a toastie maker and smoothie maker - speaker system
