### **Speeding and Support to CSW**

I am currently working with John Derryman, who has volunteered to help me better support our CSW teams and make Wiltshire safer. John will provide a fuller consultation and brief once we have the detail agreed in Devizes Police HQ. In the interim could you please let your people know we are on the case. John will be pleased to hear from you directly in the interim and his email address is included.

We are currently organising the CSW teams into regional groups under a county lead coordinator - John. Each regional group will have a lead coordinator, who will be a single point of contact with the CPTs. CSW groups will be aligned with CPT areas and not area board areas in order to make it easier to organise police support and the passage of information and data upwards and downwards. Following my email to you, John will be contacting your CSW Team Leaders to arrange a meeting and commence these activities.

For the immediate future, we will continue with letters as a deterrent but will better organise and target them. They may become superfluous as a deterrent when we make enforcement more effective. We will continually assess the situation.

Enforcement will initially be provided by 3 enforcement officers each with their own cameras. When they become self-funding, we intend to have 8 enforcement officers with admin support, one per CPT area. Enforcement will be targeted on those hot spots identified by the CSW teams. Enforcement will be reinforced, when not on other higher priority tasks, by the Road-safety Unit (RSU) Traffic Teams and also the Counter Terrorist Special Operations Fire-arms Teams as they cruise the county and region on standby for major events. Like the RSU, the CT teams also carry speed enforcement cameras.

I note that two young people were tragically killed in a traffic accident this weekend and two other young people are in a critical condition in intensive care.
