Summer Youth Programmes

BEST summer programme has finished and all who attended had a great time and the Youth & Community Co Ordinator has received lovely feedback from parents/carers. The Council had over 40 children turn up to some of the sessions. BEST was very happy with this and said it is a record. BEST is looking forward to working with the Council again in the future.

Allstarz Sports Coaching has already taken many bookings for its next sessions in Primary and Secondary aged football skills workshops.

Curry & Quiz Night

Councillor Kumar T. Naik has offered to help with the upcoming Curry and Quiz and Karaoke night by sourcing the food at a better cost than other quotes the office have received. The Council is hoping to be able to sell tickets at a subsidised rate for lonely and isolated residents.

Isolation & Loneliness (Community Choices 2022) Soft Play Trip

The soft play trip for children has been sent out to families in Haydon Wick through the Swindon Borough Council HAF Team, however, the Team has struggled to engage with this sector as no one is responding to them. The next plan is to send this to schools within the parish to see if they can advertise to parents of children who receive free school meals or pupil premium. Failing any uptake from these parents, the plan is to advertise to the wider community on social media, website, and notice boards.

Christmas Activities

Planning for Christmas has begun, and the children's entertainer has been booked ready for the youth Christmas party on Monday 19th December. Razzamatazz gets booked up very quickly, so the Council is lucky to have reserved its date. The Haydon Centre sports hall has also been reserved as this holds a bigger capacity. The Haydon Centre is also able to supply chairs for parents to watch the children enjoy the party. Razamatazz supply a reindeer character to help entertain the children, the Council will use the reindeer to also to give out gifts to each child.
