Reason for application (please continue on another sheet if necessary)	We are seeking a donation to help us fund the drastic price rise in Census insurance which has increased by approximately £20 per member this year. Without financial assistance, this price increase will severely impact on the range of activities and Camps we are able to deliver to the Guides and Rangers throughout the year. Census insurance is essential as it is how GirlGuiding pay for all the Activity insurance as well as making sure there is always Safeguarding training and mental health aid available free and in confidence for all members. The census pays for many other essential things in Girlguiding that helps us run safe, secure and well led Girl Only spaces that has been found to be really beneficial in allowing females of all religions join in. It is a totally inclusive and diverse Uniformed organisation

Girlguiding is the leading UK charity for girls and young women. Our mission is that through fun, friendship, challenge and adventure we empower girls to find their voice, inspiring them to discover the best in themselves and make a positive difference in their community. We want all girls across the UK to have the space and opportunity they need to thrive, grow and give back to their communities.

In First Greenmeadow guides and Haydon Wick Rangers we have 6 volunteers who deliver over 2150 hours of volunteer hours annually. We currently have 29 Guides and Rangers in the group of which 28 live within Haydon Wick Parish.

I have been asked to take on between 8 and 10 new members next year as we have a long waiting list of girls in this area. This is great news, but will cost us initially as we have to pay out for them early in the year for their census.

We have already started to raise funds by having a few tables at our local church fete and will be doing our own Christmas sale at our last Guide meeting. The girls will be baking cakes at home to sell during this evenings' sale.

We are looking at working with Haydon Wick Parish Council to deliver an event for the Coronation of King Charles in 2023 which we hope to be a great success and further show Girl Guiding's commitment to service within their local community much like we helped HWPC by providing girls for the opening of the play park last year.

We will continue to support HWPC in this area with our girls and leaders
