Footpath Project

The footpath project has been progressing in the background. The following footpaths have been measured by the Technical Officer:

- The main road throughout the parish from Whitworth Road, through Pond Street, on to Old Blunsdon Road.
- Haydon End Lane and HP1 footpath.
- HP1 footpath to Mouldon Hill.
- Queen Elizabeth Drive, through to Havisham Drive and join back to HP1 footpath loop.
- Queen Elizabeth through behind school to Ashdown Way.
- Whitworth Road to Pond Street.

Working Towards

The footpaths from the above main routes can identify smaller footpaths more easily. The Officer is in the process of drawing the pathways to scale with measurements so this will be the base to work from when using the parish map to indicate where each destination will be.

The footpath project is going very well in this early stage and the drawings are to scale on a simple term as straight lines of direction and labeled with measurements in meters, between pathways that go off in other directions which we can add in the future.

Some signs along Pond Street need repairs and replacements but this may be picked up in the street furniture audit that is in progress with the Head of Parks & Open Spaces and the Tidy Up Team Leader and replacements could be considered.

This will be progressed and further updates will be presented to the Committee in the future.
