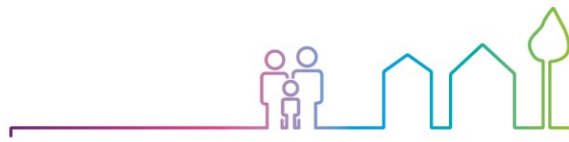

Introduction

Haydon Wick Parish Council has 18 Councillors, who are elected to represent one of two wards that make up the parish, namely Haydon Wick Ward and Haydon End Ward. There is an even split of nine Councillors in each ward. Councillors are elected to serve for a period of four years. The last election was held in May 2019 and the next elections are scheduled to take place in May 2023. The Council has four Committees, namely Community Development, Finance & Policy, Parks & Open Spaces and Planning & Highways. There is also a monthly Full Council meeting and various subcommittees, working parties and focus groups.

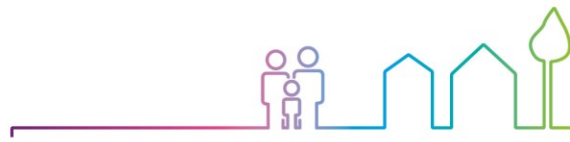
The Council is supported by the Democratic Services & Governance Team and led by the Chief Officer of the Council. The Chief Officer & RFO is supported by a Deputy Clerk & Services Manager, a Finance & Administration Manager/ Deputy RFO, Community Development Officer, Senior Administrator, Administration Assistant, and a Caretaker/Cleaner.

The Parish Council also has a Parks & Open Spaces Team, overseen by the Head of Parks & Open Spaces, which consists of 8 members of staff. The team is responsible for overseeing the grass and shrub cutting, the emptying of dog waste and litter bins and implementing new projects within the Council's open spaces.
