Town and Country Planning Act 1990
Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order) Regulations 1999

Re: Works to Ash trees within BOS TPO Woodland 35 2010.
At: 16 Silbury Mews, Moredon, Swindon, SN25 3HZ

I refer to your Application received by the Local Planning Authority on 6th January 2023 concerning the above works and confirm the following:

Under the powers of the above Order this council hereby GRANTS CONSENT for the following works:

G1, Ash (identified as 002 on application form); located to the rear of no. 17: Reduce crown height by approximately 8m and evenly reduce lateral spread to shape. Works equating to 50% of the tree's leaf area.

G1, Ash (identified as 003 on application form); located to the north of 002; Fell to ground level.

The following CONDITIONS apply to this decision:

That the agreed works be implemented within two years of the date of this permission.

All works to be implemented in accordance with BS3998/2010 'Tree work - Recommendations'.

The council also advises that:

All works are carried out by a qualified tree surgeon with appropriate insurance. A list of Arboricultural Association approved contractors operating in your area, can be obtained by consulting their website (www.trees.org.uk) or by telephone 01242 522152.

Consent is obtained from the tree owner before works are undertaken where the subject trees are not in the ownership of those who submitted the application.

Please be aware there are other legislative controls such as felling licences for woodland work and controls for the protection of certain species of flora and fauna. You should ensure that these do not apply to your proposed operations.
