If funding is successful, the Swindon sites will be the first Tiny Forest sites where green prescribing will be used, Earthwatch are keen to work with GP surgeries in the area. Earthwatch will recruit volunteer tree keepers who will carry out years 1-2 maintenance. Tiny Forest is handed over to the land owner on planting and should be built into your maintenance programme. Earthwatch advocate as little interference as possible. Planting bear rooted whips (1-1.2 metres) so the main maintenance is weeding, litter picking and watering the latter being more complicated. Volunteers are usually very keen to water as they are invested in the project so some councils arrange a bowser to be available on a certain day of the week for volunteers to water. There wasn't anything built into the grant for maintenance as it is only possible for years 2 and 3 and the Tree Keepers will deal with this. Re maintenance costs I would suggest above essential health and safety and annual inspection down the line they should be minimal.
