

LTP Implementation Plan

2025/26

This document sets out the highways and transport capital programme for 2025/26, with an indicative programme for 2026/27 and 2027/28.

The Government has confirmed Local Transport Plan grant funding for 2025/26 of £5,761,000 as set out in Table 1. This includes £375,500 incentive funding which is subject to final confirmation by the Department for Transport.
