Dear Georgina,

I wanted to let you know that Swindon Borough Council is planning a focused programme of public realm improvements in the town centre during the final two weeks of August.

While ongoing financial pressures continue to limit the level of maintenance we can provide across the borough, this initiative will concentrate existing resources in the town centre to deliver a targeted programme of enhancements that will make a visible difference to the area's appearance.

The work programme will include:

- Refurbishing benches
- Replacing damaged and worn paving
- Cleaning bins and jet washing key areas of the town centre
- Removing weeds and overgrown vegetation
- Removing graffiti from council-owned buildings and property

The Council is keen to work in partnership with local councils, community groups and volunteers to maximise the impact of this initiative, and I am writing to explore how you may be able to support the programme.

In particular, I would welcome your thoughts on:

- Whether your council could provide any personnel, equipment or other resources during this period to complement and extend the work being undertaken by the Council
- Supporting a community volunteering day that we are planning as part of the programme, either through direct participation or by helping to recruit volunteers from your local community

By working together, we have an opportunity to make a positive and noticeable improvement to the town centre environment for residents, businesses and visitors alike.

I would be very happy to arrange a call to discuss this further and explore how we can work together.
